

Italian House




This house is made with inspiration from Italy. I have cut it in 180 grams cardstock and glued it together using permanent high tack tape runner. In the cutting files there is also an inner floor included. I didn't bother to use that piece in my instruction.

Assembly instructions


1. Cut all the pieces out and glue the white parts on to the wall pieces. On the door wall part, leave the white part unglued as in picture. This have to be folded before you can glue it in place.



2. Glue the big wall parts together. Also put glue on the top tabs and bend them down.



3. Fold the roof parts as in picture and put glue on all the tabs.



4. Glue the roof together.




5. Fold the glued tabs inwards as in picture.



6. Put the roof on the wall part, ensure that the small diagonal slots in the roof are on the same side as the door opening in the wall section. Bend the wall part tabs up to the roof so it sticks together. Pinch the edges of the roof so that the roof tabs also sticks to the wall part.



7. Now it's time for the entrance. Fold the small roof part as in picture.



8. Put glue on the tabs and glue the roof edge together.





9. Attach the roof on the door wall.



10. Put glue on the upper side on the small tabs on the roof part. Also put glue on the long tabs on the door wall. Thread the tabs through the slots in the big roof and attach them. Attach the door wall to the main wall.



11. Glue the stairs together and glue them to the house.





Now the Italian House is finished! :)
